Valentine's Day Parties

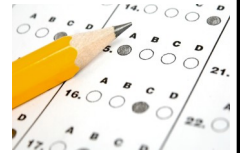
Will be held on Tuesday, February 14, for homerooms who are participating. Teachers will send information home for his/her classroom party.

When to Keep Your Child Home...

It's that time of year again when there is an increase in colds & flu.

For your child's benefit and to prevent the spread of illness, please **keep your child home** when they exhibit any of the following symptoms:

1. Child has a fever of 100.4° or higher.
2. Child has been vomiting or has diarrhea.
3. Child has difficulty breathing or shortness of breath.
4. Child has a persistent cough (lasting more than 12 hours).
5. If your child has 2 or more of the following symptoms:

- ◆ cough
- ◆ sore throat
- ◆ runny nose/congestion
- ◆ chills
- ◆ muscle pain
- ◆ headache

Students should be fever free without medication for 24 hrs. before returning to school.

Students should also be free of vomiting or diarrhea, without medication, for 24 hrs. before returning to school.
